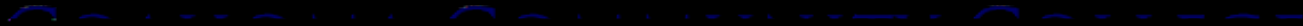
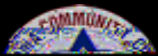


Cash-Strapped HBCUs

HBCUs**



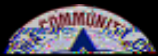


**In the last 4 years, 9 HBCUs

suspended due to finances**



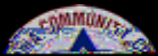


**In the last 20 years, over a

counterpart schools**



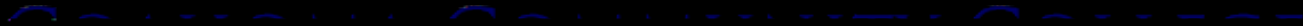
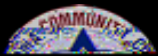
