



Total FTEIC Students Completed College Math in year 1




Total FTEIC Students Completed College English in year 1



Total FTEIC Students Persisted from Term 1 to term 2




Total FTEIC Students College Ready






Total FTEIC Students Referred to Dev Ed in 1 Subject






COAHOMA COMMUNITY COLLEGE ATHLETICS FALL 2017 MIN AND MAX TERM GPAs




