The requirements for both general and program-specific admission are:

- 1. A completed CCC application
- 2. High school or GED transcript is required.
- 3. A minimum ACT composite score of 16 or higher.
- 4. Academic transcript of all colleges attended.

Graduation Requirements

- a. Requirements for the **Paramedic Certificate**:
 - i. Eight semester credit hours of Anatomy and Physiology with labs with a
 - ii. Completion of all paramedic classes with an average of at least 80% <u>C</u> in each class
 - iii. Completion of all semester and summative cognitive, psychomotor, and affective evaluations by the medical director and program director
 - iv. Completion of all laboratory, clinical, and field requirements
 - v. Completion of one summative (comprehensive) computer exam similar to the National Registry Exam for Paramedics. (This is used to evaluate the student's readiness for the NREMT exam).
- b. Requirements for the **Paramedic Degree**:
 - i. Eight semester credit hours of Anatomy and Physiology with labs with a minimum grade C both lectures and labs.
 - ii. Completion of all paramedic classes with an average of at least 80% in each class
 - iii. Completion of all semester and summative cognitive, psychomotor, and affective evaluations by the medical director and program director
 - iv. Completion of all laboratory, clinical, and field requirements

Notification of Acceptance/Non-acceptance

Post Admittance Requirements

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BACKGROUND INFORMATION SIGNATURE FORM

All students who will be providing direct patient care in health care institutions regulated by the MS Department of Health should be aware that Mississippi law requires background checks for individuals seeking employment in a health care facility.

Each student must submit a recent criminal background clinical clearance letter by July 17, 2024).
